

THE ECLIPSE GALLERY (Updated)

The Eclipse Gallery is essentially a co-op gallery, a multi-use space, and a Mill common space. It is located in Loft #102, and showcases work from Mill artists and elsewhere, in scheduled shows and events, including but not limited to art exhibits, life drawing, workshops, musical performances, films, readings, lectures, open studios, craft sales, residencies, and other arts-oriented events.

Exhibition Schedule

The Exhibition Calendar is meant to afford Mill residents an opportunity to exhibit work and is subject to change to support shifting participation needs, at the discretion of the Gallery. The gallery schedule for the upcoming year will be distributed from time to time on the Gaggle email system and posted near the mailboxes. It is also available by request from the Gallery.

The Gallery Liaison is appointed by the Eclipse Mill Board of Trustees, and at their discretion, sets and manages the gallery Exhibition Calendar with the aim of maintaining multiple uses that meet the needs of the community. Due to the increased level of interest in exhibiting in the Gallery, solo/one-person exhibitions may be limited to every other year. Group shows are encouraged. All residents are also encouraged to submit work to the annual group show, typically set to overlap with Berkshire Art Week.

The Gallery Liaison is responsible for scheduling shows, sharing the Exhibition Calendar, collecting Gallery Agreement forms, and processing the stipend and reimbursement. A \$200 stipend is available for each show, to be distributed among the artist(s); a \$100 reimbursement for expenses is available by submitting applicable receipts. Only Eclipse Mill residents are eligible for the stipend and expense reimbursement.

Proposing a Show

If you would like to propose a Gallery show or single event (book group, meditation, visiting artist, community meeting, etc.) please consult the updated and posted Exhibition Calendar for potential dates, and then contact the Gallery Liaison to coordinate and confirm scheduling.

Complex Projects

For more complex events, for example, those requiring coordination with other organizations or non-profits, or multi-day or multi-format events, please contact the Eclipse Mill Board (totheboard@gaggle.email) for guidance on proposals.

Artist Commitment

Artists who propose a show and receive an exhibition date will receive an Agreement outlining the terms of participation in a Gallery show. Cancellation on short notice is strongly discouraged. If an artist needs to cancel their scheduled exhibition, please give at least three months' notice in order to allow the Gallery to consider a substitute show.
